

NSPB RAISON EYE HOSPITAL Raison, Dist. Kullu (HP)

The medical facilities in the hilly areas are usually under-developed and inadequate due to the difficult terrain and other problems. The NSPB-Raison Eye Hospital (NREH) at Raison, Kullu, fulfills the expectations and need in this remote area for providing good quality eye care and work towards the prevention of avoidable blindness. The various programs that are being run by experienced and qualified Doctors at NREH have been widely acclaimed. In fact, local people in the remote areas eagerly look forward to get their eye related problems treated at the NREH camps.

In order to provide continuous medical services to the people of the area, the infrastructure at the hospital had been improved and is yielding good results. NREH now has a regular Doctor who visits there for its weekly program every month to supplement the outreach activities and provide quality eye care services on a continuous and

regular basis. Surgeries are also conducted regularly every month apart from the camps held. *Low Vision Project* which has been approved by the Govt. of India is also under implementation. It is our endeavor to reach to such places where the plight of the poor needs urgent attention.

The Hospital is an icon for delivery of eye care services in the region.
