### JODHPUR (RAJASTHAN)

#### Eye Camp at Village Doli

An eye camp was organized at village Doli-35 kilometers away from Jodhpur - on the 28<sup>th</sup> March. It was



organized jointly by the NSPB-Jodhpur, Tarabai Hospital and the Sri Saraswati Senior secondary school, Doli. In the camp onsite examination and treatment of 350 patients was done by Dr. N.C.Desai. Sixty two patients were brought to Jodhpur for free cataract surgery. All patients were operated free of cost by the state-of-the-art cataract surgery called phacoemulsification and foldable lens implants were inserted in all patients free of cost.



The closing ceremony of an Eye camp was organized at the Tarabai Desai eye Hospital, Jodhpur on March 30. At the closing ceremony Dr. N.C.Desai, President NSPB and the Director of the Tarabai Hospital, welcomed the guests and informed that perhaps this was
